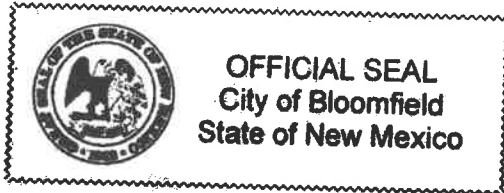
Group Work
