B. Comments from Department Heads and/or Council

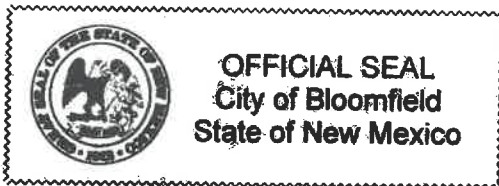
Mayor Atencio inquired about an ordinance regarding panhandling.
