SJC Fire Chief John Mohler introduced Deputy Fire Chief David Vega.

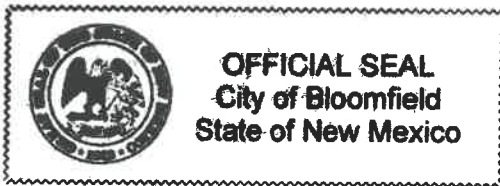
Councilor Finch made comments in regard to Project Graduation and the need for donations.
